



Shot in the USA: Gun Violence After Newtown

A 21-year-old man was fatally shot early Friday after an argument at the entrance of a St. Petersburg gas station, police said.

Caleb K. Scott and another man were in a verbal dispute about 12:15 a.m. at a BP station, at 2753 Fifth Ave. S., when the other man shot Scott several times in the chest, police said.

Scott, whose last known address was 4320 Ninth Ave. S, St. Petersburg, was transported to Bayfront Medical Center, where he died, police said.

The argument and shooting were recorded on surveillance video reviewed by police detectives.

The video shows the gunman opening the door to the BP station, then turning toward Scott, who was approaching from behind. They appear to exchange words as Scott walks past the other man into the store. Scott then turns to face the other man and they continue to exchange words.

The other man then pulled out a handgun and began shooting, police spokesman Mike Puetz said in a news release.

After the shooting, the gunman and a female fled on foot, although the man dropped his hat while leaving, Puetz said.

Police are looking for 20-year-old Damon Danterius Ford. Ford is 5'7" with a slim build. He is clean shaven and wears dreadlocks. Tattoos: "D Ford" left forearm, "Trap" right arm, "Problem" right hand, "Solver" left hand.
