



Florida man charged in infant son's death

A father in St. Petersburg is now facing a first-degree murder charge in the June death of his 7-month-old-son.

Michael David Guadalupe, 27, was arrested Thursday when St. Petersburg police reported that his son's "extensive internal injuries were inconsistent with the father's initial description of what occurred," the Tampa Bay Times reports.

On June 29, Guadalupe was with his son, Angelo, while his wife went to work. He told police Angelo became "fussy" and he called 911 when Angelo was "unresponsive," according to the Times.

The infant was taken off life support July 7, his 52nd day of life.

The Medical Examiner listed blunt head trauma as the cause of death and ruled the death as a homicide, the Times reports.
