



Man Gets 20 Years For 2011 Fa-tal Home In-va-sion

Ron-nie Betts, charged with killing a mother of two dur-ing a St. Petersburg home in-va-sion rob-bery in 2011, pleaded guilty Mon-day and was sen-tenced to 20 years in prison. Betts, 28, was con-victed on two counts of at-tempted first-de-gree mur-der and sec-ond-de-gree mur-der. On the night of March 23, 2011, Betts barged into a house in Jordan Park where a group of fam-ily and friends were play-ing cards. He fa-tally shot Ebony Ste-wart, 27, who an-swered the door. Betts also fired at two oth-ers who re-cov-ered from their in-juries.

Betts, 28, was con-victed on two counts of at-tempted first-de-gree mur-der and sec-ond-de-gree mur-der.
